- Early entries must be **RECEIVED** by September 15, 2017. Your **SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER** and **SIGNATURE** are **REQUIRED** on your Entry Form.

Exhibitors are responsible for the behavior of their animals. Unruly animals may be dismissed.
- PARKING & PASSES:** All vehicles pulling trailers with horses aboard will be allowed to enter the East Gate. Vehicle and admission passes will be issued upon arrival at the barn when stalling horses. One complimentary vehicle pass and two complimentary admission passes will be issued per exhibitor and must be picked up at the barn. Vehicles with vehicle passes may park in Lots 5 or 6. All other vehicles must park outside gates and all other personnel must purchase admission tickets at gate. When leaving the grounds, be sure to have your hand stamped at the gate to be able to return the same day at no charge.

**SHOW DIVISIONS**

**Heavy Draft Show Hitch HD-S**

- Open to purebred Percherons, Belgians, Clydesdale & Shires only.
- Eligible for classes marked **HD** and **HD-S**, and age/sex appropriate heavy draft halter classes
- Show harnesses (scotch collars) required.

**ATTENTION SIX HORSE HITCHES**

- ALL ENTRIES** in the **North American Classic Six Classes # 8, 53 & 77** Must be members of the NASHHCS. Join at [www.naclassicseries.com](http://www.naclassicseries.com)

- Horses may not be cross entered in heavy draft pleasure classes

**Heavy Draft Pleasure HD-P**

- Open to purebred Percherons, Belgians, Clydesdales & Shires only.
- Eligible for classes marked **HD** and **HD-P**, and age/sex appropriate heavy draft halter classes
- NO Show harnesses (no scotch collars).
- Horses may not be cross entered in heavy draft show hitch classes.

**Light Draft LD**

- Open to Spotted Drafts, Friesians, Fjords, Haflingers, Gypsy Vanners, Drums, Brabants. American Creams, Suffolks & Draft Crosses (must show draft characteristics).
- Eligible for class # 1, 2, 4, 5, 6, 7, 54, 58, 60, 62, 75, 76, 78, 81, 84, 86
- Horses may not be cross entered in heavy draft show hitch or pleasure classes.

**GENERAL RULES**

- HORSES AGE** shall be computed on the basis of a calendar year starting January 1 of the year foaled.
- SHOW CONDITION:** Each animal must be in show condition and deemed worthy by the judge to receive premiums.
- JUNIOR EXHIBITORS:**
  - Age of youth is based on their age on January 1 of each year
  - Junior Drivers must be accompanied by an adult in all Junior Driving Classes
  - No youth exhibitor may show a stallion in ANY class.
- PROPER DRESS:**
  - Halter Classes: Exhibitors as well as helpers will be required to be in proper show dress while in the show ring. (NO BLUE JEANS OR SHORTS).
  - Performance Classes: Men: Sport Coat & Tie. Ladies: Dressy dress, long skirt & blouse or pants suit (Hat & Gloves optional).
  - Under Saddle: (1)Western: Western show shirt or blouse, show pants (blue jeans allowed). western hat. (Vest, chaps optional) (2)English: Complete show attire according to the discipline.
- HEAVY DRAFT HALTER CLASSES:** ALL MARES and STALLIONS must be registered with their respective breed's association and registration number **MUST** be on the Entry Form to enter class.
- GEORGIA OWNED & BRED:** Entrant must be a Georgia resident who owned the dam at time of breeding and currently owns the offspring.
- PLEASURE DRIVING** will not be judged by any Carriage Association rules.
- OBSTACLE COURSES** and rules will be available when signing for those classes and will be posted at the Show Office.
- SPORTSMANSHIP:** Any unsportsmanlike conduct by an exhibitor will disqualify both exhibitor and horse from the show.
- BE ON TIME** for each class you have entered.
  - the show ring gate will be closed after five (5) minutes or a third call by Ringmaster, \*\*Exhibitor will not be allowed to enter the ring.
  - If you wish to withdraw from a class, please let the Ringmaster and/ or the Bookkeeper know in advance so the class will not be held up. (\*\***Note: There is no refund of class fees**)
- INTERFERENCE WITH JUDGE:** The judge shall report to the management any exhibitor or exhibitors who in any way, whether in person or by agents or employees, interfere with him during his adjudication or manifest any disrespect to him, whereupon a proper apology from such exhibitor shall be demanded. Any exhibitor who refuses to comply with this rule may be excluded from further competition and the management may withhold from such exhibitor any premiums that may have been awarded to him.
- The show committee reserves the right to add, delete, or combine classes as the committee deems necessary.
- Any entry excused for any reason during a class will forfeit placing & prize money.
- PROTEST:** Protests must be filed in the show office within one hour of occurrence. There is a \$250 fee (returnable only if protest is decided in your favor). Decisions will be determined by show committee and will be final.

Attention - All Youth Draft Horse Exhibitors!  
Georgia National Fair, Perry, GA - October 12-14, 2017

This is a Hi-Point competition for all Youth Exhibitors with two divisions for both Heavy Draft and Light Draft. There is no enrollment required for this award. Every Youth that competes (with any horse/team) in any combination of the qualifying classes is eligible and will be automatically entered: (youth exhibitors may not show a Stallion in any class)

The Points will be counted as follows: 1st – 10 Points, 2nd – 9 Points, 3rd – 8 Points, 4th – 7 Points, 5th – 6 Points, 6th – 5 Points, 7th – 4 Points, 8th – 3 Points, 9th – 2 Points, 10th – 1 Point, all remaining exhibitors 1 point each. In the event of a tie for any of the places – the youth with the greatest number of 1st places will be the winner. If a tie remains, it will go to the youth with the greatest number of 2nd places, and so on.

All Youth exhibitors will be called to the show ring Saturday night before the Ladies Cart Championship. There, a Memorial for Pia and Kim will be read out by our announcer, the results will be announced and awards will be presented to the winners and all youth exhibitors.

We have received a request from Mr. Jim Bazzinotti to add Mr. Kim Smith to this Memorial along with receiving additional funds for a new Light Draft Division. In Mr. Bazzinotti's own words: *"It's an honor and truly fitting to acknowledge Mr. Kim Smith in this Memorial Youth Challenge. Kim (and Lawana) were instrumental in welcoming and introducing us to the GDHA and the wonderful world of draft horses. In fact, they helped us get our first Clydesdale, Major, whom Pia cherished. Kim was the first person to show up, give Major a hoof trim, and help us get settled in with Major. It was watching his tireless efforts that we came to know true selfless horsemanship and the love of these majestic and powerful gentle giants."*
