2. Items in this Department may be entered at different Skill Levels, **but all entries using the same method or technique must be entered in the same Division.** For example, **an exhibitor may be at the Open Division level in Cross Stitch, but a Novice in Knitting.** Management reserves the right to move work to a higher skill level if merited.

3. Exhibitors may enter as many classes as they wish, but **not more than two entries per class**, and each entry must exhibit a different style, design, or purpose. Up to 5 items allowed in "Other Not Listed" classes, **as long as each entry is different by style, design, or purpose, and items do not fit in another category.** The "Other Not Listed" category may not be used as a means to exceed the limitation of two items per class.

4. The name of any pattern used should be listed on the entry form or in the notes section of online entry.

5. Entries must be in excellent condition. Incomplete, torn, or soiled items will not be accepted.
